

# WHERE



Many of the innovations you will see in this edition of Xylexpo/Sasmil stem from the availability of a large, new exhibition centre. Thus, this year, the **WHERE** factor is one of the most important elements; it will be structured in a completely new way thanks to the cutting-edge solutions, the large spaces, the logistics and the services that the **new Milan exhibition centre in Rho** can provide for exhibitors and visitors alike.

Getting there is quite simple: **the new home for the Xylexpo/Sasmil** is, in fact, just 8 kilometres as a crow flies from the old Milan exhibition centre and can easily be reached by public transportation and by car.

## Arriving by underground

- > Take the M1 Red line in the direction of Rho-Fiera and go all the way to the last stop. Ticket for out-of-town rates. Transfer stations: Cadorna-Triennale and Loreto (M2 Green line); Duomo (M3 Yellow line).

## Central Railway Station and Garibaldi Railway Station

- > Take the M2 Green line in the direction of Abbiategrasso and get off at the Cadorna-Triennale stop; then take the M1 Red line in the direction of Rho-Fiera and go all the way to the last stop.

## Cadorna Railway Station (Ferrovie Nord)

- > Take the M1 Red line in the direction of Rho-Fiera and go all the way to the last stop.

## Linate Airport

- > Buses run every hour to and from the Milan Exhibition centre.
- > Take Bus 73 to Milan San Babila; then take the M1 Red line in the direction of Rho-Fiera and go all the way to the last stop.

## Malpensa Airport

- > Buses run every hour to and from the Milan Exhibition Centre.
- > Malpensa Express train runs every 30 minutes to Cadorna Station (last stop); then take the M1 Red line in the direction of Rho-Fiera and go all the way to the last stop.

## Orio al Serio Airport

- > Buses run every 30 minutes to and from the Stazione Centrale; then take the M2 Green line in the direction of Abbiategrasso and get off at the Cadorna-Triennale stop; then take the M1 Red line in the direction of Rho-Fiera and go all the way to the last stop.

## Arriving by car

- > From the A7 Milano-Genova and A1 Milano-Bologna motorways, drive in the direction of Milan: take the Tangenziale Ovest (West Ring Road) north and follow the signs for Fiera Milano.
- > From the A4 Milano-Venezia motorway, drive in the direction of Milan: continue in the direction of the A4 Motorway to Torino or, before the Milano Est toll booth, take the Tangenziale Nord (North Ring Road) and follow SP 46 Rho-Monza, then follow the indications for Pero-Fiera Milano.
- > From the A4 Milano-Torino motorway, drive in the direction of Milan: take the Pero-Fiera Milano exit or take the Tangenziale Ovest (West Ring Road) north and follow the signs for Fiera Milano (the Milan Trade Fair).
- > From the A8 Milano-Varese and A9 Milano-Como/Chiasso motorways, drive in the direction of Milan: take the Fiera-Porta Est exit, pass the Milano Nord toll booth. To enter the Exhibition centre from the West Gate (Fiera-Porta Ovest), take the Tangenziale Ovest (West Ring Road) and follow the indications for Fiera Milano.
- > From the A8 Milano-Varese motorway, drive in the direction of Varese-Como and take the Fiera Milano exit.
- > From Milan, take Viale Certosa and continue down Via Gallarate/SS 33 del Sempione and follow the indications for Fiera Milano.

## Where to park

Again for parking, **HOW** is not a problem: visitor parking is located just outside the fence and can accommodate 10,000 cars, the greatest concentration is near the West Gate (Porta Ovest). Additional parking is also available at some underground stations:

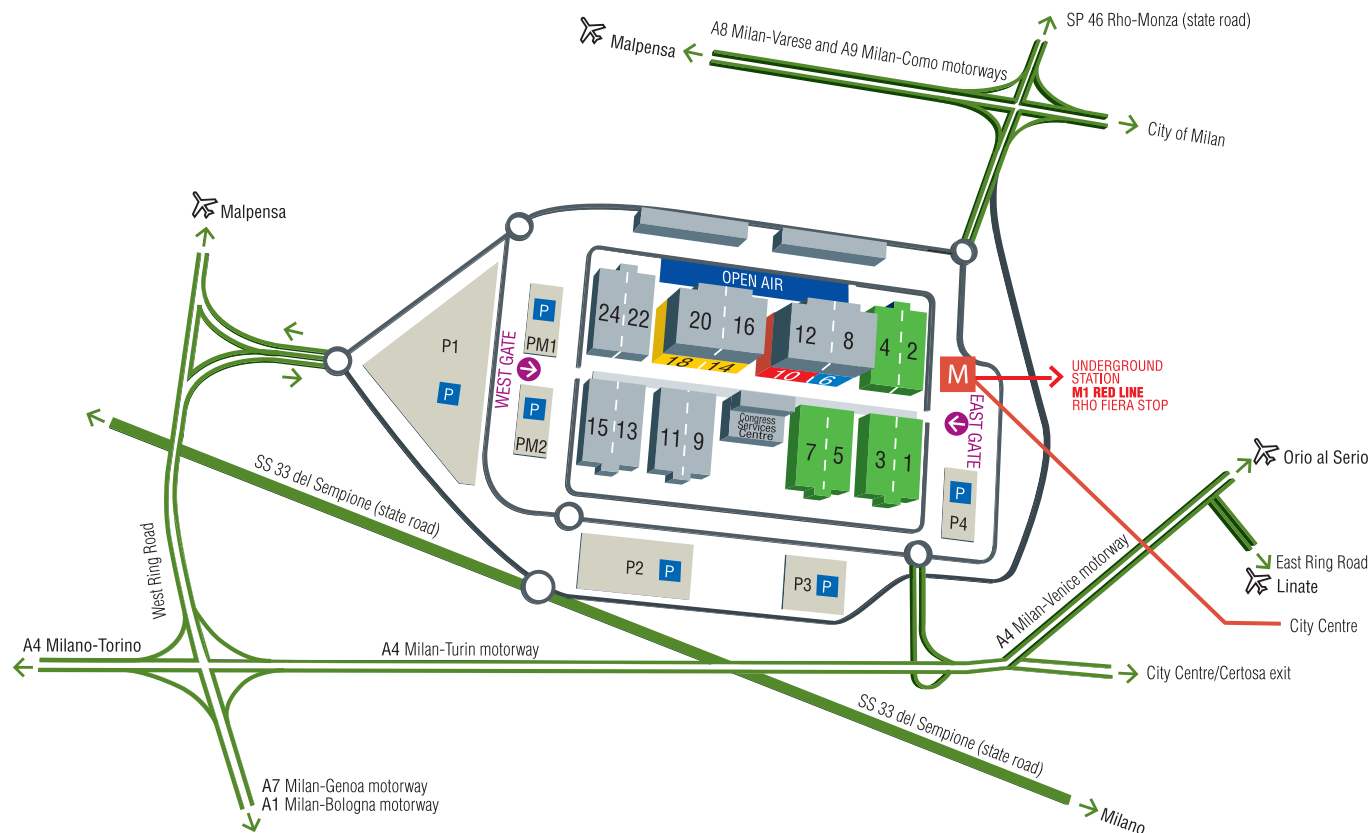
- > Bisceglie, Molino Dorino, Lampugnano (M1 Red line).
- > Famagosta, Cascina Gobba (M2 Green line).
- > San Donato (M3 Yellow line).
